

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE A 20MPH SPEED LIMIT ON SOME ROADS IN WILLINGTON

Reason for Proposal:

Willington Parish Council have requested that the speed limit be reduced to 20mph on Church Road and Chapel Lane (in the vicinity of Sheerhatch Primary School), following complaints about speeding in this area.

The proposed 20mph speed limit is intended to provide a safer road network for all highway users, including motor cyclists, pedal cyclists and pedestrians, and carers with children on their way to and from the Primary School.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce a 20mph speed limit covering the entire length of each of the following roads in Willington:-

Chapel Lane	Mowbray Place
Church Road	Church End
Beauchamp Place	Churchill Place
Station Road	Russell Drive
Gostwick Place	Warren Farm
Grange Way
