



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO REDUCE THE EXISTING WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN WADSWORTH COURT, ELSTOW

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to reduce the extent of the waiting restriction that was introduced by a recently made Traffic Regulation Order but has not yet been implemented on site.

Effect of the Proposal:

- 1. To reduce the extent of the existing 'No waiting at any time' restriction on the following length of road: -**

A	Wadsworth Court, Elstow
(i)	On its north-western kerb, from the projected centre of the roundabout extending in a south easterly direction for 13 metres. The proposed amendment reduces the current restriction from approx. 30 metres to 13 metres.

The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
