



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN WADSWORTH COURT, ELSTOW

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Elstow Parish Council for an extension to existing parking restrictions in Wadsworth Court, Elstow. This is in response to concerns raised over inconsiderate parking at this location which affects visibility and safety, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

Effect of the Proposal:

- 1. To introduce a 'No waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road: -**

A	Wadsworth Court, Elstow
(i)	On its north-eastern kerb, from a point 5.5 metres northwest of the boundary between numbers 16 and 18 Wadsworth Court, extending for a distance of approx. 30 metres in a north westerly direction, to the projected centre of the roundabout
(ii)	On its north-western kerb, from a point 5.5 metres northwest of the boundary between numbers 16 and 18 Wadsworth Court extending for a distance of approx. 30 metres in a north westerly direction, to the projected centre of the roundabout.

Relevant proposal documents may be examined during normal office hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, MK42 9AP. They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
