MODIFICATION ORDER 2025**

The above Order, made on 20 February 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a length of Public Footpath in the Parish of Little Staughton to be numbered 27 in the Definitive Statement that commences where it has a junction with the public road known as "Staughton Road", Little Staughton approximately 48 metres north-east of the property known as "New Farm," Little Staughton at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 1052/6431 shown as Point A on the map attached to this order then running in a northern direction for approximately 321 metres to the Pertenhall Parish Boundary at OSGR TL 1050/6463 shown as Point B on the attached map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge by appointment at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
