



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN WEST END, ELSTOW

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Ward Councillors to introduce new parking restrictions in West End, Elstow. This is in response to concerns raised over inconsiderate parking at this location which affects visibility and safety, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

Effect of the Proposal:

- 1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road: -**

A	West End, Elstow
(i)	Extending from the projected centre of the junction of West End and St Marys Close on its eastern kerb, for a distance of approx. 30 metres in a northerly direction.
(ii)	Extending from the projected centre of the junction of West End and St Marys Close on its western kerb, for a distance of approx. 25 metres in a northerly direction.
(ii)	Extending from the projected centre of the junction of West End and St Marys Close on its western kerb line for a distance of approx. 6 metres in a westerly direction.
	<u>West End, Elstow</u>
(i)	Extending from the projected centre of West End on its eastern kerb for a distance of approx. 12 metres in a southerly direction.
(ii)	Extending from the projected centre of West End on its eastern kerb for a distance of approx. 9 metres in an easterly direction.
(iii)	Extending from the projected centre of West End on its southern kerb for a distance of approx. 12 metres in a southerly direction.
(iiii)	Extending from the projected centre of West End on its southern kerb for a distance of approx. 14.5 metres in a westerly direction.

The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
