BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO IMPROVE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IN SEVERAL LOCATIONS IN WIXAMS BY ESTABLISHING NEW ZEBRA CROSSINGS

Reason for Proposal: **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Bedford Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under the Zebra, Pelican and Puffin Pedestrian Crossings Regulations and General Directions, proposes to establish zebra pedestrian crossings at the locations specified below in the interest of pedestrian safety

Locations of Established Crossings:

A	Bedford Road, Wixams
	At its junction with Green Lane, extending north westwards for approx. 25.9 metres.
B	Southern Cross, Wixams
	At its junction with Bedford Road, extending in both a westerly and easterly direction for approx. 21 metres in each direction.
C	Green Lane, Wixams
	From a point adjacent to the western boundary wall of No. 54, extending eastwards for approx. 43.2 metres.

Further Details of the proposed zebra crossing, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossing may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the www.bedford.gov.uk/tro website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossings are commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
