


Located in the south of Bedford Borough, Wootton has a similar age profile to the Borough but with a much higher proportion of residents aged 40-74 (49%). A broad mix of non-White British residents form 10% of the population.

Almost two-thirds of households are couples, and pensioners form 25% of all households. Wootton has high home ownership (82%), with 11% of households renting from social landlords and 7% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (44%) and semi-detached (33%), and heated by gas (89%).

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (29%) is among the lowest of all parishes. There is high employment in skilled trades (14%) and 6% of residents aged 16+ have completed an apprenticeship.



The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (27%) is below the average for rural parishes, and 19% of residents have no qualifications. There is high provision of unpaid care (13%).

While 11% of households do not have a car, 36% have 2 cars, and 14% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (82%), and levels of commuting by train (3%) and cycling or walking (5%) to work are both low.
