Grange Estate – Footpath 16 crosses, Bridleways 6, 17, 1 cross;


Green Gateway – Footpath 19, 33, A4, A3 cross, Bridleway 23 abuts and crosses;

DECLARATION

Statement under s. 31(6) Highways Act 1980

We, (Maston Vale Trust) being the owners of the above land as defined in s. 31(7), enclose by way of deposit with Bedford Borough Council a map whereon that land is shown in (orange transparency), and state that (the ways coloured green are admitted to have been dedicated as bridleways) (and) (the ways coloured pink are admitted to have been dedicated as footpaths) (but that) no (other) ways over the said land are admitted to have been dedicated as highways of any type.


NB All of the landowners must sign the declaration.

Bedfords Green Gateway


