

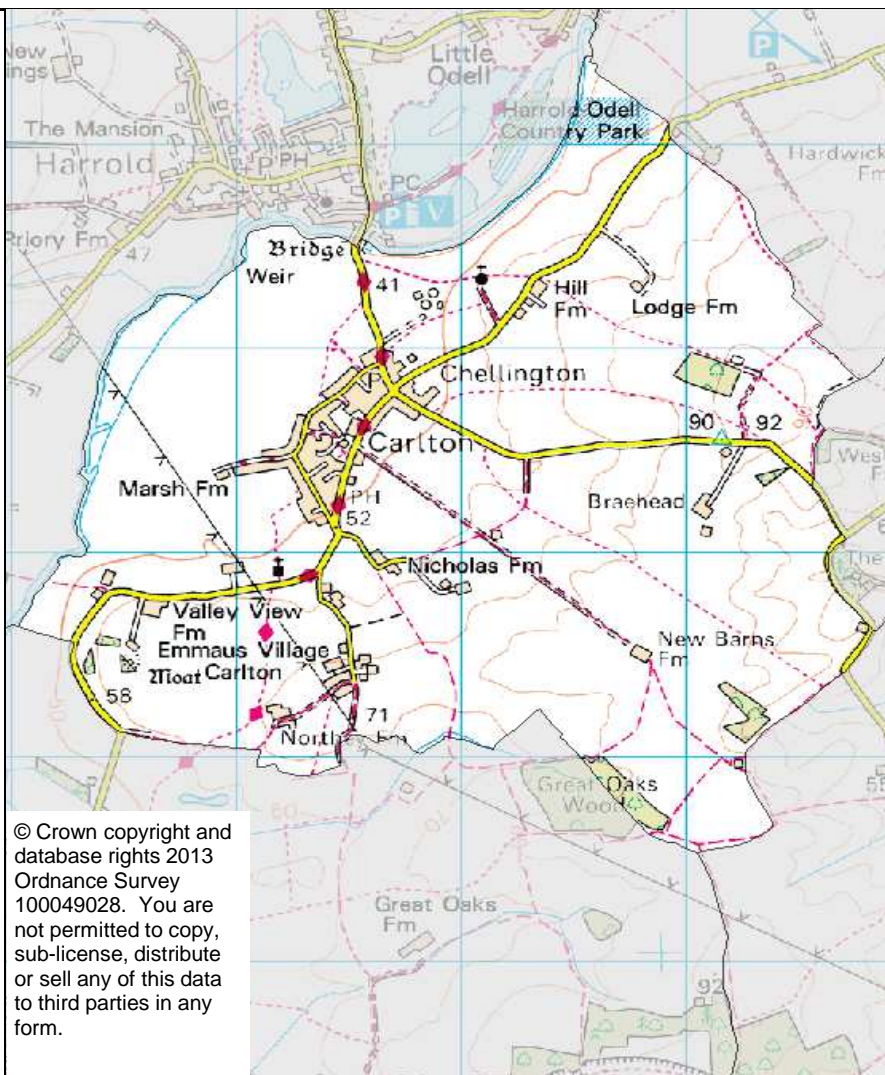

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Located in the west of Bedford Borough, Carlton and Chellington has an older age profile than the Borough with a quarter of residents aged over 65. The proportion of non-White British residents (5%) is among the lowest of all parishes.

Pensioners form a third of all households. Almost 6% of households are lone parents with dependent children. The level of home ownership (82%) is high, with 5% of households renting from social landlords and 13% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (65%) and semi-detached (27%). Almost 80% of homes are heated by gas.

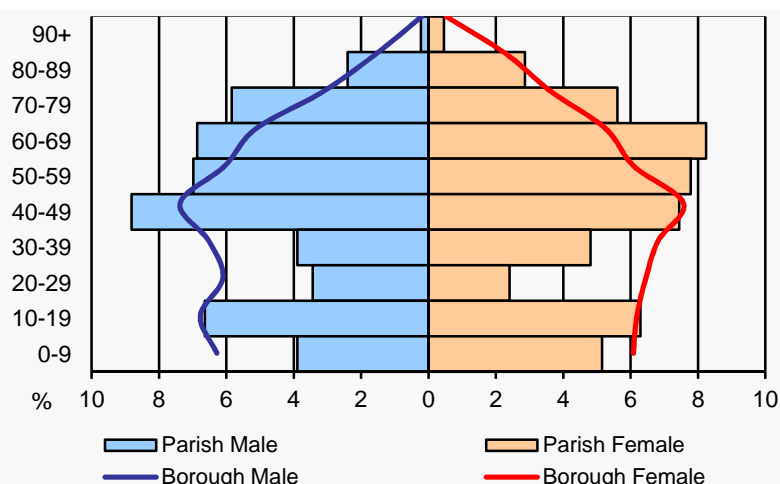
Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (44%) is among the highest of all parishes. Self employment (14%) levels are high and 11% are employed in skilled trades.

Residents aged 16+ holding degree-level qualifications (41%) exceeds the average for rural parishes, and a low proportion (13%) have no qualifications.

Only 7% of households do not have a car, 43% have 2 cars, and 13% have 3 or more. Commuting by train (6%) exceeds the Borough average, most people (72%) travel to work by car, 13% work from home, and 8% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which exceeds the rural average.
