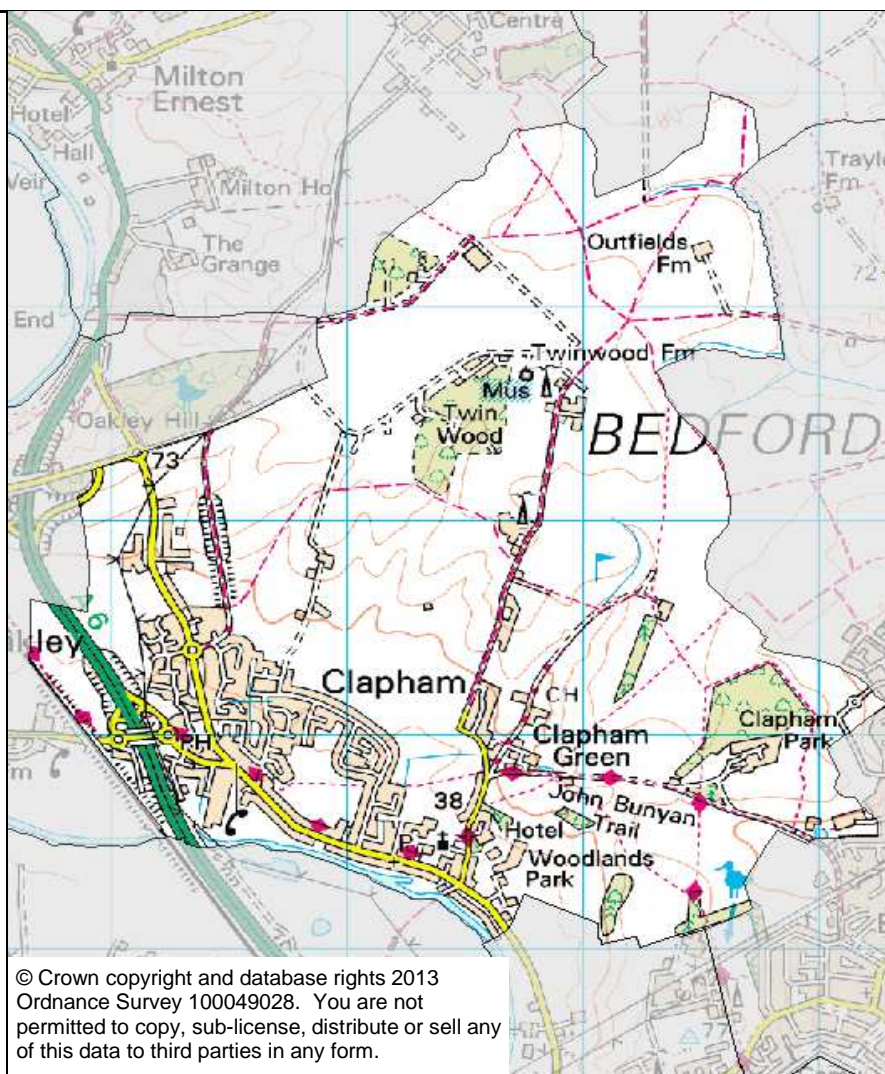

Located north west of Bedford Town, Clapham has a similar age profile to the Borough, and one of the higher levels of non-White British residents of all parishes (18%). Clapham's population rose by an estimated 900 between 2001 and 2011.

There is a high proportion of one-person households (29%), evenly divided between pensioners and non-pensioners, and 8% of households are lone parents with dependent children. Home ownership (78%) is high, with 9% of households renting from social landlords and 12% renting privately.

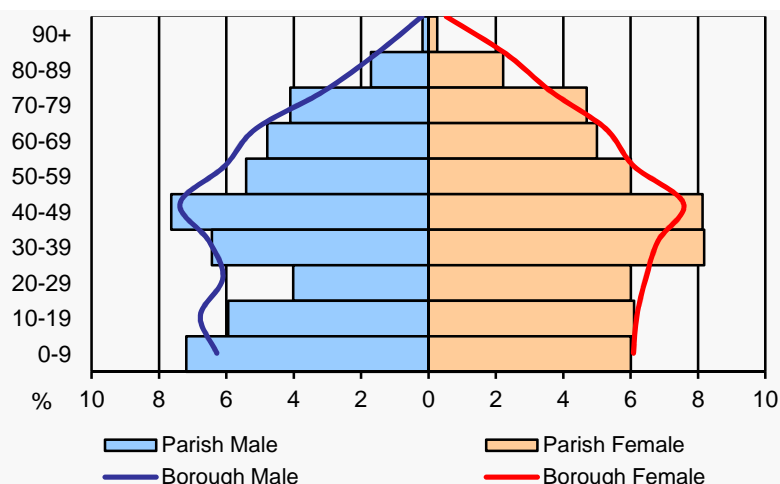
Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (28%) is among the lowest of all parishes, but is close to the Borough average. 13% of those in employment work in skilled trades.

Residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (26%) is below the Borough average, and 20% of residents have no qualifications. The health of residents and the provision of unpaid care are both very similar to the Borough average.

The level of households without a car (14%) is among the highest of all parishes, and the proportion with 3 or more cars (9%) is among the lowest. Most people travel to work by car (76%), 5% commute by train, but 10% cycle or walk to work, which is above the average for all parishes.


