






Located in the south of Bedford Borough, Elstow has a young age profile, with 23% of residents aged 0-15, and only 10% aged over 65. Elstow has the highest level of non-White British residents of all parishes (34%), including 20% Asian/Asian British. Elstow's population rose by almost 600 between 2001 and 2011.

There is a low proportion of one-person households (20%), mainly non-pensioners. Lone parents with dependent children form 7% of all households. Home ownership is 72%, with 15% of households renting from social landlords and 13% renting privately. Housing is a broad mix of detached (41%), semi-detached (30%) and terraced (25%) dwellings.

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (31%) is among the lowest of all parishes, though it still exceeds the Borough average, and 11% are employed in skilled trades. The economic activity rate (79%) among those aged 16-74 is very high. Degree-level qualifications are held by 30% of residents aged 16+, but 18% have no qualifications. Health levels are better than Borough averages, reflecting Elstow's younger age profile.

Only 9% of households do not have a car, 39% have 2 cars, and 14% have 3 or more. Most people (81%) travel to work by car, 5% commute by train, 5% work from home, and only 6% cycle or walk to work.
