

Located in the north of Bedford Borough, Felmersham has a slightly older age profile than the Borough, with a high proportion of residents aged 40-69. The level of non-White British residents (4%) is among the lowest of all parishes.


There is a low proportion of one-person households (17%), evenly divided between pensioners and non-pensioners. Felmersham has very high home ownership (88%) with 8% of households renting privately and 4% from social landlords. Two-thirds of housing is detached, almost 20% is semi-detached, and 63% of homes are heated by oil.

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (40%) exceeds the average for all parishes, and self employment (14%) is also high.

The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (45%) is among the highest of all parishes, and a low proportion (10%) of residents have no qualifications. Health levels are good, despite the older age profile.

Only 4% of households do not have a car, 50% have 2 cars, and 20% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (77%), levels of commuting by train (7%) are high, and 10% work from home. Only 4% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is below the rural average.
