




Located on the northern boundary of Bedford Borough, Pertenhall has an older age profile than the Borough with a high proportion of residents aged over 50 (46%). The level of non-White British residents (2%) is among the lowest of all parishes. *NB: Percentages in this Profile are based on small numbers.* 

There is a high proportion of one-person households (25%), mainly pensioners. Pertenhall has high home ownership (81%) with 7% of households renting from social landlords and 12% renting privately. Most houses are detached (74%) and 54% of homes are heated by oil. The level of residents with a long-term illness or disability (12%) is relatively low, and 13% of residents provide unpaid care.

Self-employment (20%) is extremely high and employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (38%) is above the average for all parishes. Employment in skilled trades (15%) and working from home (16%) are both high. Residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (44%) is well above the average for rural parishes.

The level of households without a car (4%) is among the lowest of all parishes, and 28% of households have 3 or more cars which is among the highest levels. Most people travel to work by car (70%), but commuting by train is high (6%), and 6% also cycle or walk to work.


