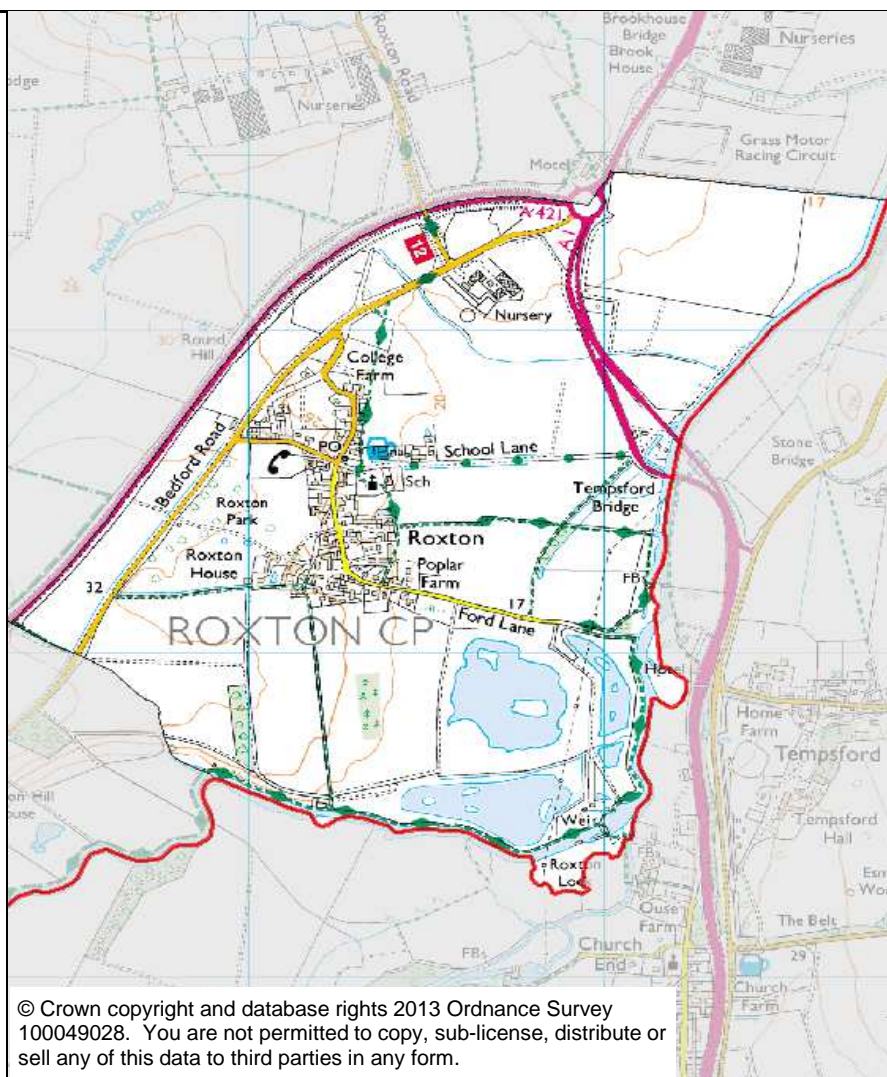

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Located on the eastern boundary of Bedford Borough, Roxton has an older age profile than the Borough with only 15% of residents aged 0-15 but 19% aged over 65. Residents are highly concentrated in the 40-69 age group. The non-White British population is 7% of the total.

Home ownership (67%) is relatively low for the rural area, though it still equals the Borough average. Roxton has the highest proportion of households renting from social landlords (22%) of all parishes, and a further 11% rent privately. Housing is predominantly detached (46%) and semi-detached (33%).

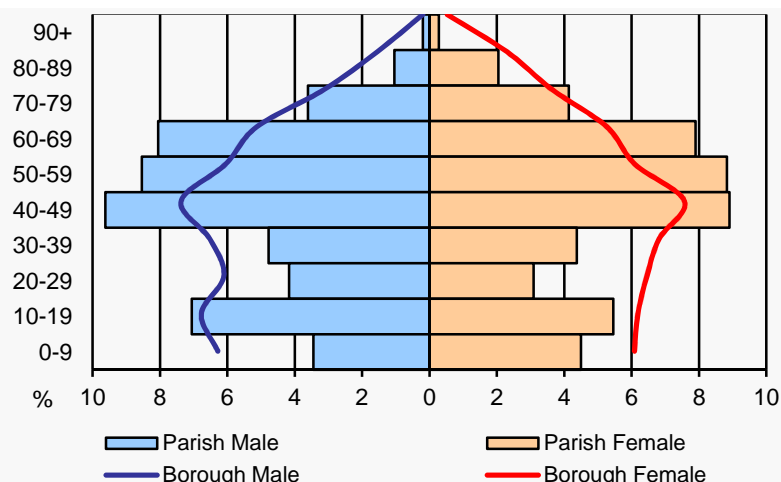
Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (34%) matches the average for all parishes. Employment in skilled trades (15%) is high. Residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (25%) is among the lowest of all parishes, and 21% have no qualifications.

While 11% of households do not have a car, 35% have 2 cars, and 21% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (76%), 13% work from home, commuting by train (2%) is the lowest of all parishes, and 5% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is below the rural average.

Due to the 2007 Parish boundary changes, this 2011 Census Profile has been compiled using 'best fit' estimation. Accordingly, all Roxton data should be regarded as indicative only.
