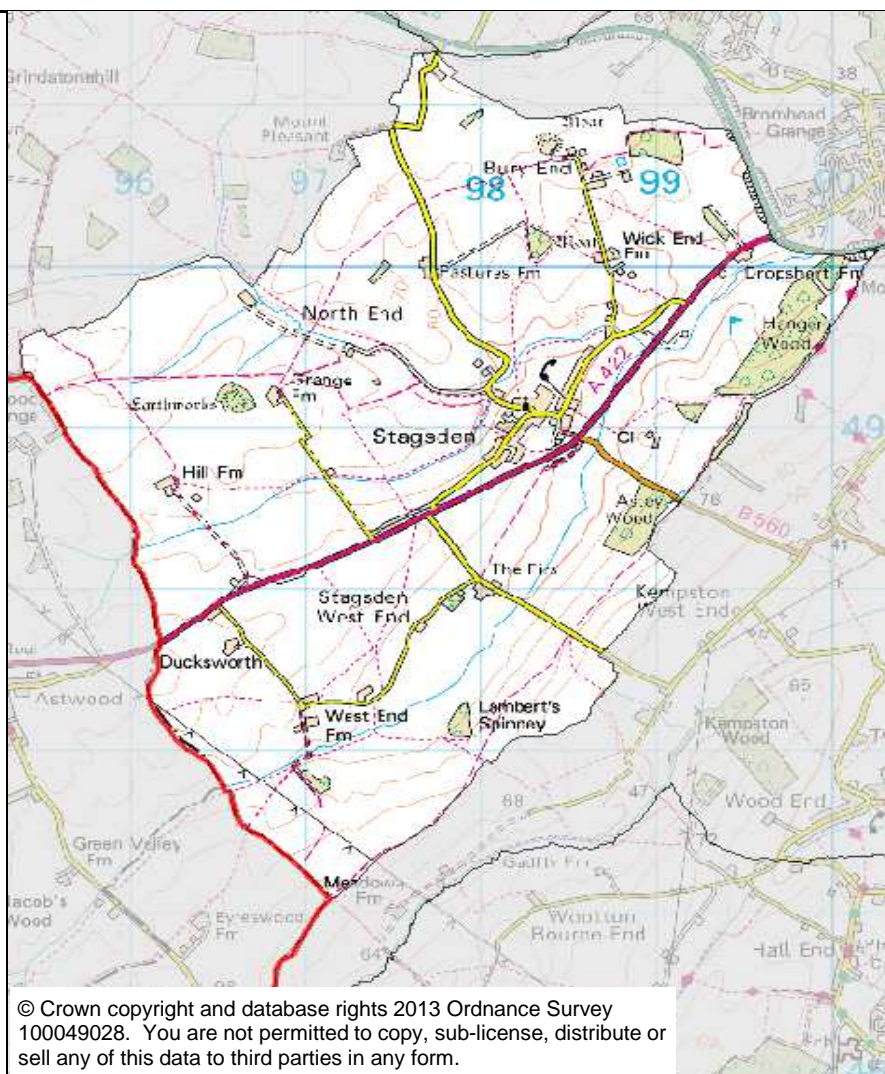

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Located in the south west of Bedford Borough, Stagsden has an older age profile than the Borough, with only 16% of residents aged 0-15 but 23% aged over 65. There is a high concentration of residents in the 40-69 age group. The non-White British population is 8% of the total. Two-thirds of residents state their religion as Christian.

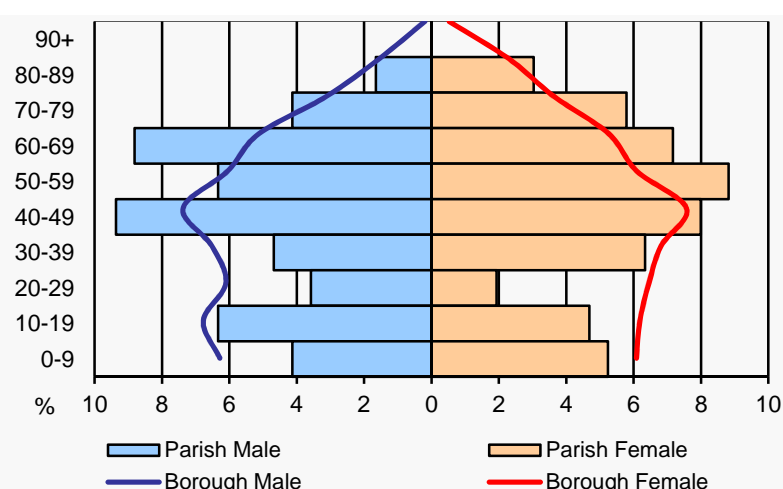
Stagsden has high home ownership (73%), with 10% of households renting from social landlords and 17% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (48%) and semi-detached (41%), and 59% of homes are heated by oil. Provision of unpaid care by Stagsden residents (15%) is high.

Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (42%) is well above the average for all parishes. Self employment (15%) and employment in skilled trades (13%) are also high. Residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (36%) exceeds the average for rural parishes, and a low proportion (14%) of residents have no qualifications.

The level of households without a car (10%) slightly exceeds the rural average, but 39% of households have 2 cars, and 19% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (78%), 9% work from home, levels of commuting by train are low (4%), and 7% of those in employment cycle or walk to work which matches the average for rural parishes.
