
## Stewartby




Located in the south of Bedford Borough, Stewartby has a slightly younger age profile than the Borough, with 23% of residents aged 0-15 and only 15% aged over 65. A broad mix of non-White British residents form 8% of the population.

Stewartby has the highest proportion of one-person households (34%) of all parishes. Home ownership is 70%, with 25% of households either renting from private landlords or living rent free, and 5% renting from social landlords. Housing is predominantly semi-detached (49%) or terraced (36%), with most homes heated by electricity (41%) or oil (32%).

While the overall economic activity rate among those aged 16-74 is very high (79%), self-employment (9%) and working from home (5%) are among the lowest of all parishes. Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (22%) is the lowest of all parishes. A high 15% of those in employment work in skilled trades. Only 17% of residents aged 16+ have degree-level qualifications and a high proportion (25%) have no qualifications.

The level of households without a car (14%) is well above the average for all parishes, though 11% of households have 3 or more cars. Most people travel to work by car (85%), commuting by train is just 3%, and 5% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is below the average for all parishes.
