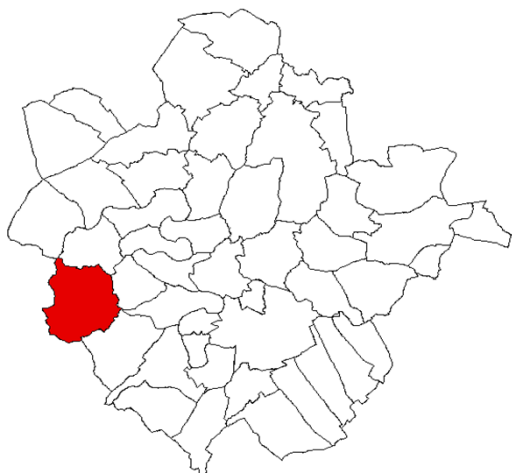

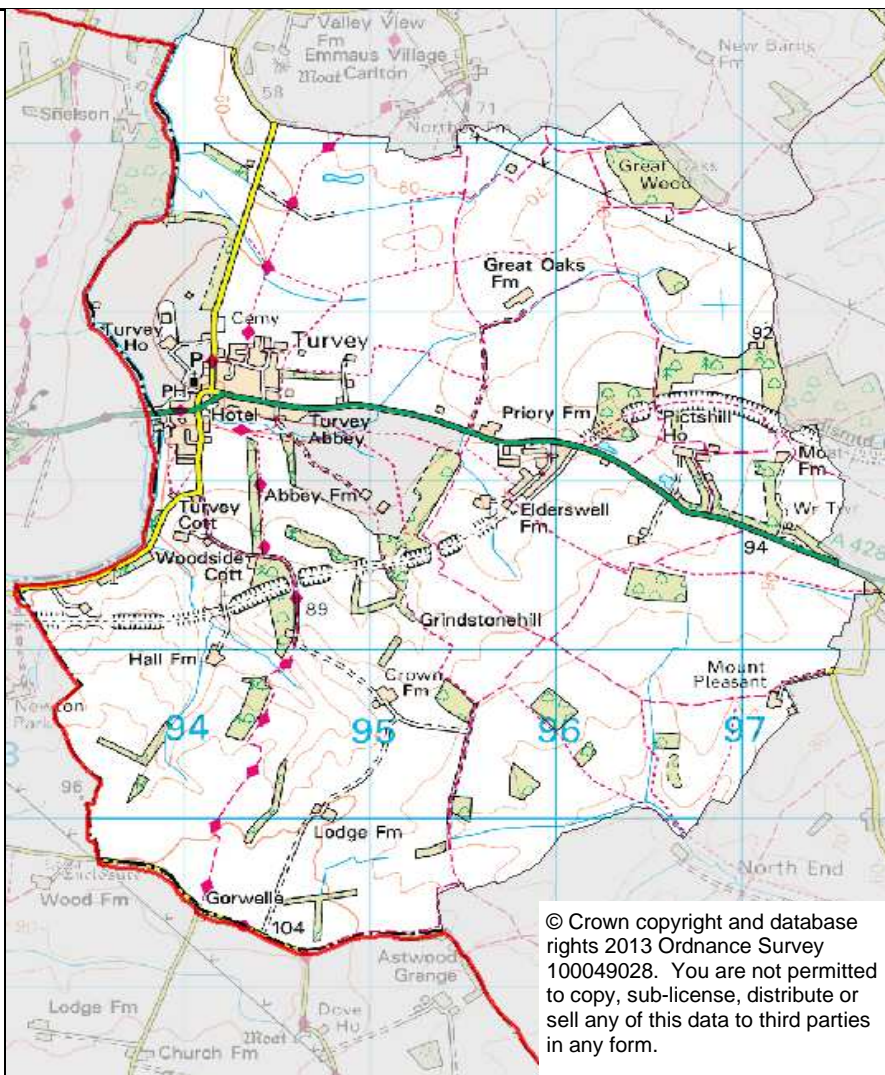

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Located on the western boundary of Bedford Borough, Turvey has a similar age profile to the Borough with 18% of residents aged 0-15 and 18% aged over 65, but relatively few people aged 20-39. A broad mix of non-White British residents form 8% of the total population.

A majority of households (63%) are couples, though there is a high proportion of one-person households (25%), mainly pensioners. Home ownership is 69% with 12% of households renting from social landlords and 19% renting privately. Housing is a mix of detached (42%), semi-detached (28%) and terraced (27%) dwellings, and a majority of homes are heated by gas (81%).

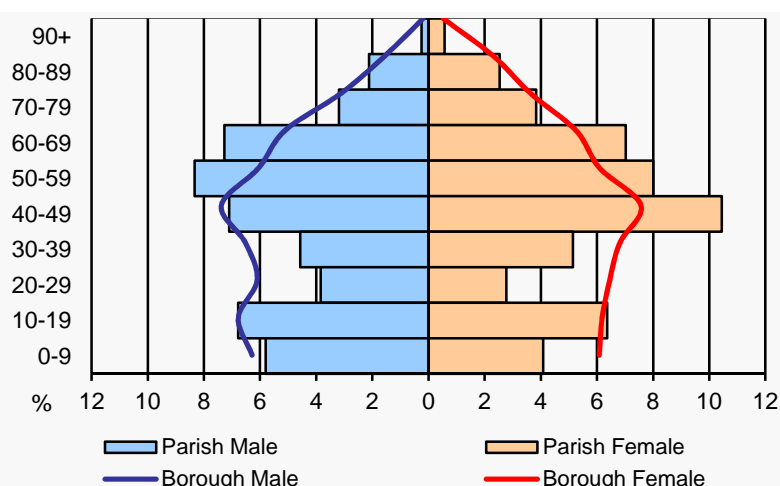
Self-employment (15%) and working from home (10%) are both relatively high, and employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (40%) is well above the average for all parishes.

The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (42%) is also well above the average for rural parishes, and only 14% have no qualifications.

Only 9% of households do not have a car, 38% have 2 cars, and 18% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (73%), but levels of commuting by train are high (7%), and 7% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which matches the average for rural parishes.
