


### Parish Profile

Located in the east of Bedford Borough, Wilden has an older age profile than the Borough with few residents aged 18-39 and more than half of the population aged over 50. The non-White British population is 8% of the total. More than 72% of Wilden residents state their religion as Christian.


Wilden has high home ownership (80%) with 8% of households renting from social landlords and 11% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (62%) and heated by oil (63%). The proportion of residents providing unpaid care (17%) is among the highest of all parishes.

Self-employment (15%), working from home (13%), and employment in skilled trades (14%) are all high. Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (38%) exceeds the average for all parishes.

The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (35%) slightly exceeds the rural average, and 18% of residents have no qualifications.

Only 7% of households do not have a car, 43% have 2 cars, and 26% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (78%), levels of commuting by train (4%) are low, and just 3% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is among the lowest of all parishes.
