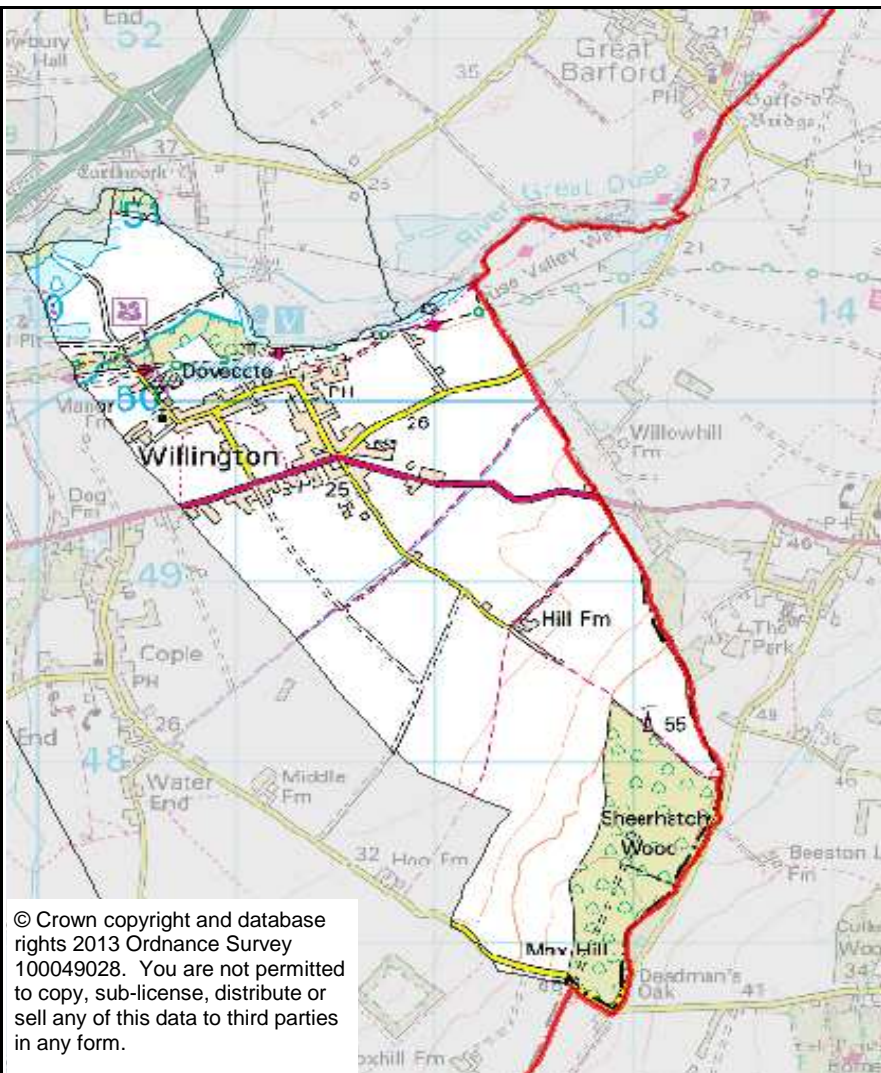

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Located on the eastern boundary of Bedford Borough, Willington has an older age profile than the Borough, with only 14% of residents aged 0-15 but 27% aged over 65. The non-White British population is 8% of the total.

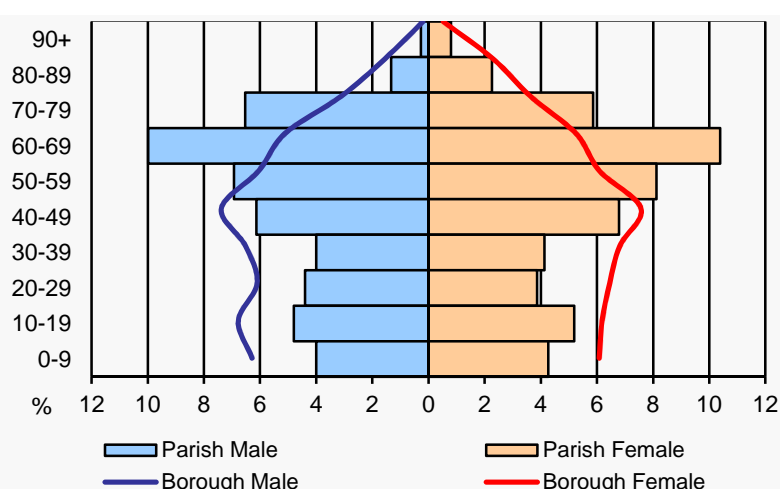
Two-thirds of households are couples, and the proportion of one-person households (21%), mainly pensioners, is below the average for rural parishes. Willington has high home ownership (85%), with 8% of households renting from social landlords and 7% renting privately. A majority of houses are detached (56%) and over 80% are heated by gas. A high proportion of residents provide unpaid care (13%) and 17% of residents have a long-term illness or disability.

Self-employment (15%), working from home (11%) and employment in skilled trades (13%) are all high. Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (38%) exceeds the average for all parishes. Residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (32%) is slightly below the rural average, and 19% of residents have no qualifications, though this also reflects Willington's older age profile.

While 11% of households do not have a car, 41% have 2 cars, and 19% have 3 or more. Most people (73%) travel to work by car, 5% commute by train, but 8% of those in employment cycle or walk to work, which is above the average for rural parishes.
