

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BEDFORD URBAN AREA (SOUTH OF THE RIVER AND QUEENS PARK)) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009 (AMENDMENT NO.40) ORDER 2020

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 4th September 2020 and may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.40) Order 2020".
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:-
 - The plan schedule reference "Grid Reference K 37 Revision No: 3" (i) shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Reference K 37" Revision No: 4" shall be inserted.
- 3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.


