- 1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday**, **6 May 2021** to decide on the question below:
- 2. The question which will be asked in the referendum is;

'Do you want Bedford Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Stevington to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

- 3. The referendum area is **Stevington** as identified on the map
- A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on Thursday, 6May 2021
 - He/She is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum are (the deadline for registration is Monday 19 April 2021)
 - His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the Register of Electors, the address in respect of which he or she entitled to be registered.
- 5. The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2390.08 The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 476.
- 6. The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedure which are similar to those used at local government elections.
