## Temporary Protective Screens in Private Hire/Hackney Carriage Vehicles

I agree to remove the protective screen in less than 21 days after the current social distancing restrictions relating to COVID-19 have been removed

I agree that the temporary protective screen in my vehicle will:

- not be permanently installed in the vehicle
- not have a solid frame to the screen
- only be fitted with either Velcro or adhesive fastenings (which can be removed from the vehicle when the screens are no longer allowed)
- be fitted in such a way so as not to affect the structural integrity of the vehicle, or interfere with any manufacturer fitted safety equipment e.g. air bags
- not wrap around the driver seat and create a partition between the two front seats, in addition to the rear cabin area.
- The film / sheet used must be clear and transparent and can only be fitted behind both front seats, creating a partition between the front and back area of the vehicle.
