SEXUAL ENTERTAINMENT VENUE LICENCE APPLICATION NOTICES

GUIDANCE NOTES

Completion of Notice

1. Insert the full name and address of the applicant in block capitals.
2. Insert the date upon which the application was delivered to the Council.
3. The address of the premises must be given in block capitals.
4. Insert the proposed opening and closing times for Sexual Entertainment Venues only, otherwise delete this section.
5. Describe the type of entertainment to be provided by Sexual Entertainment Venues only, otherwise delete this section.
6. The date upon which the notice is first displayed must be inserted.

Display of Notice

1. Applicants are required to post an A3 Notice at the proposed site for 21 days from the date the application is lodged with the Council, setting out the application details. The Notice must be posted in a prominent position for the whole of that time and be easily read by passers-by.
2. Applicants are also required to place a public notice in a local newspaper circulating within Bedford Borough. A specimen advertisement is available from the Licensing Service at Bedford Borough Council. The newspaper Notice should appear in the publication within 7 days of the application being lodged.

THE NOTICE MUST BE SECURELY AFFIXED ON OR NEAR THE PREMISES TO WHICH IT RELATES FOR A PERIOD OF 21 DAYS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE.
