



Notice of Making a Public Path Order  
Highways Act 1980

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (WILDEN: PART OF FOOTPATH No. A10)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021**

The above Order made on 09 September 2021 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert a length of Public Footpath number A10 Wilden commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number A10 Wilden to be retained at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0958/5471 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally southerly direction for 146 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number A10 to be retained at OSGR TL 0956/5456 shown as Point B on the order map to a line running from a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number A10 Wilden to be retained at OSGR TL 0958/5471 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally westerly, south westerly, south-easterly and easterly direction for 255 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number A10 Wilden to be retained at OSGR TL 0956/5456 shown as Point B on the order map.
