**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (WOOTTON: FOOTPATH No. 10)  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2021**

The above Order made on 09 September 2021 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish all of Public Footpath number 10 Wootton that is situated in the environs of Hall Farm Road between a point at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9989/4543 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a westerly direction for 255 metres to a point at OSGR SP 9964/4545 shown as Point B on the order map.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
