**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (MILTON ERNEST: BRIDLEWAY FROM
OLD MILTON ROAD (UC 31) TO MILTON ERNEST BRIDLEWAY No. 7)
PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER 2021**

The above Order made on 16 June 2021 under Section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 will create a length of Public Bridleway in the Parish of Milton Ernest that commences at a point where it has a junction with the publicly maintained part of "Old Milton Road", Thurleigh (Road UC 31) at the parish boundary between Milton Ernest and Thurleigh at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0374/5707 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally south-westerly direction for approximately 333 metres to a point where it has a junction with Public Bridleway number 7 Milton Ernest at OSGR TL 0348/5687 shown as Point B on the Order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge displayed at the main entrance to Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to the Bedford Borough Council, Manager for Traffic Operations, Room 436, Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP or by email to highways.consultations@bedford.gov.uk not later than Friday 10 September 2021, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
