(Odell: Byway Open to All Traffic No.42) Modification Order 2022

The above Order, made on 1st September 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a length of Byway Open to All Traffic in the Parish of Odell to be numbered 42 in the Definitive Statement commencing from a point where it has a junction with the northernmost extent of the Borough Highway "Church Lane" which is shown on the List of Streets as a highway maintainable at public expense approximately 55 metres south west of Byway Open to All Traffic No. 4 Odell at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9677/5918 shown as Point "A" on the Order Map then running in a generally north-eastern direction for 55 metres to a point where it joins with Byway Open to All Traffic No. 4 Odell at OSGR SP 9679/5922 shown as Point "B" on the Order Map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
