

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN THE NEWNHAM WARD OF BEDFORD**

**Reason for Proposal:**

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Newnham Ward councillors for some parking restrictions at a couple of junctions due to concerns raised about parked vehicles affecting visibility and safety there. The proposals outlined below are intended to resolve those concerns by keeping the areas free of parked vehicles.

**Effect of the Order:**

1. To introduce “No waiting at any time” restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

<b>A</b>	<b>Hatfield Crescent, Bedford</b>
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from a point approx. 15 metres northwest of its easternmost junction with Aylesbury Road for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a north-westerly direction.
<b>B</b>	<b>Kingsley Road, Bedford</b>
(i)	On its southern kerb, extending from the centre of Tennyson Road for a distance of approx. 14 metres in a westerly direction.
(ii)	On its southern kerb, extending from the centre of Tennyson Road for a distance of approx. 14 metres in an easterly direction.
<b>C</b>	<b>Tennyson Road, Bedford</b>
(i)	On both sides of the road, extending from Kingsley Road for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a southerly direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (“the Council”) in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the “Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.\*\* ) Order 20\*\*” and shall come into force on \*\* \*\*\*\* 20\*\*.
2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
  - (i) The plan schedule reference “Grid Ref: O 26 Revision No: 3” shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference “Grid Ref: O 26 Revision No: 4” shall be inserted.
  - (ii) The plan schedule reference “Grid Ref: M 28 Revision No: 5” shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference “Grid Ref: M 28 Revision No: 6” shall be inserted.
3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens

Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.
