



# Mayor's Climate Change Fund Case Study

## Greys Primary Provision

Greys Primary Provision is owned by Bedford Borough Council, but is managed by Bedford Inclusive Learning and Training Trust (BILTT) who have submitted this application with Bedford Borough Council's support. The building they applied for was a previously unused swimming pool, which has now been converted into two SEN classrooms. The building is approximately 50 years old and has an EPC rating of G. Bedford Borough Council are currently doing other works to transform the building into the SEN classrooms such as covering in the swimming pool

Through the Mayor's Climate Change Fund, the school has been able to fit board insulation between the rafters in the roof of the building.

The building relies mainly on gas powered central heating, and installing insulation was one of the recommendations from their EPC. The suppliers have estimated that the additional insulation will create a 15% saving on gas, which means they will save around £977.54 and 35779.92kWh which is approximately 6.55tCO<sub>2</sub>e annually.

These works were completed in September 2022 with the Mayor's Climate Change Fund providing 50% match funding for the cost of fitting the improved light system, a sum of £9,076.20.
