## **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

The vehicle must be moved on the instructions of a Police Officer or Civil Enforcement Officer.

The vehicle must not stand:

- so as to cause obstruction in any way to pedestrians or vehicles;
- within 10m (approx. 32ft) of any junction, traffic signal controlled junction, bus stop, school entrance or hospital entrance;
- in a bus or cycle lane during the hours of operation;
- in a parking bay or space of any kind; or
- wholly or partially on any footway or verge;
- close to traffic lights or any junction.

This waiver is only valid as shown above and it is not a general dispensation. It must be placed behind the windscreen of the vehicle so that it can be clearly seen from the outside. If the vehicle is not being used for the purpose specified, or the conditions of this notice are not complied with, the waiver will be cancelled and the vehicle shall be treated as if there was no waiver displayed or issued. A penalty charge notice may be issued. This waiver is only valid on public highway and not on areas of private land or on any verge or footway.

Materials or goods must not be deposited on the footway or carriageway (except immediately at the rear of the vehicle with agreement from the Highway Authority), or pass across any part of the footway or carriageway in such a way to interfere with other vehicles or pedestrians. If the waiver is for continuous loading or unloading, the vehicle must not be left unattended for more than five minutes at any one time.
