

Notice of Making a Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

Bedford Borough Council

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (MILTON ERNEST: BRIDLEWAY NO. 13 and OAKLEY: PART OF BRIDLEWAY No. 7) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

The above Order made on 02 February 2023 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Public Bridleway numbered 13 Milton Ernest commencing from a point where it has a junction with the A6 "Bedford Road, Milton Ernest" at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0197/5495 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally easterly direction for 95 metres to a point where it meets the Parish boundary of Oakley shown as Point X at (OSGR) TL 0206/5494 on the Order Map, which joins Bridleway 7 Oakley forming part of this order, then running in an easterly direction for 624 metres to a point where it has a junction with Bridleway numbered 8 Oakley unaffected at OSGR TL 0269/5492 shown as Point B on the attached map and divert the Bridleways to a point where it has a junction with the northern end of Bridleway No. 10 Oakley at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0195/5465 shown as Point C on the attached map then running in a generally north east, direction for 446 metres and then in a generally easterly direction for 200 metres and then north-east for 12 metres and then east for 22 metres where it connects with Public Bridleway No. 8 Oakley unaffected at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0263/5477 shown as Point D on the attached map.
