

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN QUEEN'S DRIVE AND ARROW LEYS, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Ward councillors for new parking restrictions either side of the existing zebra crossing in Queens Drive at the Arrow Leys junction, Bedford. This is in response to concerns raised over inconsiderate parking at school start and finish times, which affects visibility and safety, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce "No waiting, Mon - Fri, 8:00 - 8:45am, 3:00 - 4:30pm' restrictions (single yellow line) on the following lengths of road:

Α	Queen's Drive, Bedford
(i)	On its north-eastern kerb, extending from the centre of Arrow Leys for a
	distance of approx. 11 metres in a north-westerly direction.
(ii)	On its north-eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 36 metres north-
	west of the centre of Arrow Leys for a distance of approx. 20 metres in a
	north-westerly direction.
(iii)	On its north-eastern kerb, extending from the centre of Arrow Leys for a
	distance of approx. 20 metres in a south-easterly direction.
(iv)	On its south-western kerb, extending from a point approx. 34 metres north-
wes	west of the projected centre of Arrow Leys for a distance of approx. 20 metres
	in a north-westerly direction.
(v)	On its south-western kerb, extending from a point approx. 1.5 metres south-
	east of the projected centre of Arrow Leys for a distance of approx. 17.5
	metres in a south-easterly direction.
В	Arrow Leys, Bedford
(i)	On both sides of the road, from the north-east side of Queen's Drive
	extending for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a north-easterly direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.81) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 15th May 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: N 20 Revision No: 2" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: N 20 Revision No: 3" shall be inserted.
- 3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.


