

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN FOLKES ROAD ,ASHPOLE AVENUE & HARRIS WAY, WOOTTON

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to introduce parking restrictions in Folkes Road, Ashpole Avenue, and Harris Way, and access restrictions in Folkes Road loop. The restrictions are deemed necessary to maintain safety for highway users of the main access roads into the development, and those attending the school in Harris Way.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

Α	Folkes Road, Wootton	
(i)	On its western kerb, extending from a point approx. 13 metres south west of	
	the projected south western wall of house no. 40 Folkes Road in a southerly	
	direction to the northern loop of Folkes Road.	
(ii)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 8 metres south west of the	
	projected south western wall of house no. 39 Folkes Road in a southerly	
	direction to the northern loop of Folkes Road.	
(iii)	On the north side of its northern loop, from the centre of Folkes Road for a	
	distance of approx. 14 metres in a westerly direction.	
(iv)	On the north east side of its northern loop, from the centre of Folkes Road	
	extending in a southerly and then south westerly (clockwise) direction to a	
	point approx. 50 metres south west of the centre of Harris Way.	
(v)	On the south side of its northern loop, from a point approx. 14 metres west of	
	the centre of Folkes Road extending in a southerly and then south westerly	
	(clockwise) direction to Ashpole Avenue.

(i)	On its north eastern kerb, extending from Folkes Road for a distance of	
	approx. 10 metres in a north westerly direction.	
(ii)	On its south western kerb, extending from Folkes Road for a distance of	
	approx. 22.5 metres in a north westerly direction.	
С	Harris Way, Wootton	
(i)	At its south eastern end, on its south eastern kerb and then on its north	
	eastern kerb extending from its south eastern end for a distance of approx. 63	
	metres in a north westerly direction.	
(ii)	On its north eastern kerb extending from a point approx. 122.5 metres north	
	west of its south eastern end to Folkes Road.	
(iii)	On its south western kerb extending from a point approx. 122 metres north	
	west of its south eastern end to Folkes Road.	

1. To introduce 'No waiting Mon – Fri 8am – 5pm' restrictions (single yellow line) on the following length of road:

Α	Harris Way, Wootton			
(i)	On its north eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 63 metres north			
	west of the south eastern end of the road for a distance of approx. 59.5			
	metres in a north westerly direction.			

2. To introduce "No stopping on entrance markings" restrictions on the following length of road:

	Harris Way, Wootton
(i)	On its south western kerb, in 2 identical sections, extending from the south
	eastern end of the road for a combined distance of approx. 76 metres in a
	north westerly direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Parish of Wootton, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) Order 2016 (Amendment No.4) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 5th June 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Wootton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The new plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: G 9 Revision No: 0" shall be inserted.
 - (ii) The new plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 9 Revision No: 0" shall be inserted.
- 3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Wootton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 as amended.




