

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO ADD A LOCATION IN ST LEONARD'S AVENUE, BEDFORD TO THE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request to extend parking restrictions in St Leonard's Avenue, Bedford. Parking at this location obstructs access to premises.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:

Α	St Leonard's Avenue, Bedford	
(i)	On its north-western kerb of the northern arm, from a point approx. 18.6	
	metres south-west of the south-western side of Station Road extending for a	
	distance of approx. 15.8 metres in a south-westerly direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 (Amendment No.24) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 22nd May 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: K 30 Revision No: 1" shall apply.
- 3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2017 as amended.




