which will be to prohibit any person proceeding on foot or on horseback or lead a horse or cycle along the

length of Odell: Bridleway No 31 and Felmersham: Bridleway No 8 which extends from its junction with Mill

Lane Odell at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) SP 9652 5775 to the OS GR SP 9711 5712 junction

with Carlton Road Felmersham has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for

Transport until 6th January 2024.

This temporary closure is required as the bridge is unsafe. The closure will continue from Friday 7th

July 2023 for up to six months.

There is no alternative routes for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works

which it is proposed to carry out on or near to bridleways have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the

works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of

the Secretary of State for Transport.
