

Notice of Making a Public Path Order Highways Act 1980

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BEDFORD: PART OF FOOTPATH No. 1) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

The above Order made on 29 June 2023 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Public Footpath numbered 1 in Bedford commencing from the unaffected part of Footpath 1 Bedford approximately 26 metres west-south-west of 108, Brookfield Road, Bedford at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0678/5077 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a north-west direction for approximately 237 metres to a point where it has a junction with that part of the unaffected Public Footpath number 1 to be retained at OSGR TL 0655/5085 shown as Point B on the Order Map and divert the Footpath to a point approximately 26 metres west-south-west of 108, Brookfield Road, Bedford commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Footpath number 1 to be retained at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0678/5077 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally south west direction for approximately 286 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference OSGR TL 0656/5059, where it has a junction with the public road known as "Polhill Avenue" shown as Point C on the Order map.

Compensation for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order is payable under Section 28 as applied by section 121(2) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended by the Transport and Works Act 1992) that are copied with this notice.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford by appointment from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). A copy of the Order as made and the Order Map have been placed and may be downloaded free of charge from the Bedford Borough Council Website. If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
