

## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (30MPH SPEED LIMITS) (THE PARISH OF BLETSOE) ORDER 2021

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (30mph Speed Limits) (The Parish of Bletsoe) Order 2021" and shall come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2021.
- As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the following Orders shall be revoked:
  - THE COUNTY OF BEDFORDSHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO. 20) ORDER 1979
  - THE COUNTY OF BEDFORDSHIRE (RESTRICTED ROADS) (THE AVENUE, BLETSOE) ORDER 1999
  - THE COUNTY OF BEDFORDSHIRE (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) (COPLOWE LANE, BLETSOE) ORDER 2003
  - BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BOURNE END LANE, BLETSOE) ORDER 2012
- 3) As from the date upon which this Order comes into force any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 4) No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 5) No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

### SCHEDULE

### A 30mph speed limit shall apply on the following lengths of road:

	metres northeast of its junction with the A6 Rushden Road to a point		
	approximately 715 metres northeast of its junction with the A6 Rushden Road		
	(a distance of approximately 575 metres).

(i)	hat length of Coplowe Lane which extends from its junction with The Avenue		
	to its junction with Thurleigh Road (a distance of approximately 1,120 metres).		
С	Bourne End Lane, Bletsoe		
(i)	That length of Bourne End Lane which extends from its junction with the A		
	Rushden Road to its junction with Thurleigh Road (a distance of

## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (30MPH SPEED LIMITS) (THE PARISH OF BLETSOE) ORDER 2021

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

Bedford Borough Council have received a request from Bletsoe Parish Council to reduce the speed limit on the section of Coplowe Lane, Bletsoe that is currently the National Speed Limit (60mph). It is proposed to reduce this to 30mph, in keeping with the rest of Coplowe Lane.

Coplowe Lane is a minor, narrow country lane increasingly used by ramblers, dog walkers, horse riders and cyclists etc., and safety concerns have been raised about the speed of vehicles in relation to these other road users.

Hence, this proposal is aimed at providing a safer road network for all highway users and to help encourage more people to embrace outdoor exercise.

Bletsoe also has other 30mph speed limits which are currently detailed on four separate Legal Orders. For administrative and simplification reasons it's further proposed to revoke these four existing Orders and to amalgamate their existing speed limits into one new Legal Order with the aforementioned proposed new limit.
