

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO AMEND SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN IDDESLEIGH ROAD, MARLBOROUGH ROAD AND WESTBOURNE ROAD, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposals:

Bedford Borough Council propose to introduce some electric vehicle recharging points and bays in Iddesleigh Road, Bedford to help encourage the use of electric vehicles instead of conventionally-fuelled vehicles. This is also intended to help cut emissions, promote sustainable transport and improve local air quality, as electric vehicles have zero tailpipe emissions.

A time-limited "Loading only" bay is proposed for Iddesleigh Road near to some business premises to assist with the loading and unloading of goods.

It is also proposed to revoke some parking restrictions in Iddesleigh Road and Marlborough Road, Bedford to create some additional parking areas, thus increasing the on-street parking capacity.

As well as the above, there is a proposal to extend some parking restrictions by 10 metres outside All Saints Church in Westbourne Road. This is intended to help improve safety for visitors to the church and pedestrians in general by keeping that area clear of parked vehicles.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce two "Electric vehicle recharging point only" bays at the following location and subject to the following restrictions:

Road:	Iddesleigh Road, Bedford			
Location:	On its southern kerb, extending from a point approx. 8 metres east of Westbourne Road for a distance of approx. 10 metres in an			
	easterly direction.			
Restrictions:	At all times: Only electric vehicles that are recharging will be			
	permitted to park in these bays.			
	8 am - 6 pm: Maximum stay 4 hours, no return within 1 hour.			
	6 pm - 8 am: No time restrictions.			

2. To revoke part of a single yellow line restriction (No waiting Mon - Sat, 8 am - 6.30 pm) and to mark a "Loading only" bay in its place at the following location and subject to the following restrictions:

Road:	Iddesleigh Road, Bedford			
Location:	On its northern kerb, extending from the projected common			
	boundary of property numbers 51 and 49 Iddesleigh Road for a			
	distance of approx. 7.3 metres in a westerly direction.			
Restrictions:	8 am - 6.30 pm: Loading only, maximum stay 15 minutes, no return			
	within 1 hour.			
	6.30 pm - 8 am: No restrictions.			

3. To revoke a single yellow line restriction (No waiting Mon - Sat, 8 am - 6.30 pm) and to mark a parking area in its place at the following location and subject to the following restrictions:

Road:	Iddesleigh Road, Bedford		
Location:	On its northern kerb, extending from a point approx. 11 metres east of Westbourne Road for a distance of approx. 36 metres in an easterly direction.		
Restrictions:	8 am - 6.30 pm: Maximum stay 2 hours, no return within 1 hour.		
	6.30 pm - 8 am: No restrictions.		
	This parking area will be partially marked on the footway to help maximise the remaining carriageway width for traffic.		

4. To revoke a double yellow line restriction (No waiting at any time) and to mark a parking area in its place at the following location:

Road:	Marlborough Road, Bedford
Location:	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 3.4 north of the
	centre of Westbourne Road for a distance of approx. 16 metres in
	a northerly direction.
	This parking area will be partially marked on the footway to help
	maximise the remaining carriageway width for traffic.

5. To extend existing "No waiting at any time" and "No loading at any time" restrictions on the following length of road:

	Westbourne Road, Bedford
(i)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 13 metres north of the
	centre of Iddesleigh Road for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a northerly
1	direction.

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.53) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 31st July 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 28 Revision No: 9" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 28 Revision No: 10" shall be inserted.
 - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 29 Revision No: 5" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: H 29 Revision No: 6" shall be inserted

3. This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (South of the River and Queens Park)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.


STATEMENT OF REASONS





75mm wide double yellow lines to Diagram 1018.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Extend double yellow lines, 10m length, on the north-eastern side of Westbourne Road. Re-paint existing 'No loading at any time' marks, extend marks at 2m intervals, to Diagram 1020.1 (to match existing) for the extent of the double yellow lines extension. No loading sign in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. New sign to be fixed to new 76mm galvanised steel post, min. height above ground 2.3m, oriented to face the carriageway. Post to protrude no higher than top edge of sign. Re-instate footway.







Remove existing signs from post and lamp column, and replace with new signs where shown, signs oriented to face the carriageway.

Fix new sign S1 to new 76mm diameter galvanised steel post (with end cap), 3.67m long, 1.0m deep foundation. Sign mounted 2.3m above ground, orientated to face the carriageway.

Re-instate footway.


