



Notice of Making a Public Path Order
Highways Act 1980

(STEWARTBY: PART OF FOOTPATH No. 3)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

The above Order made on 07 December 2023 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Public Footpath numbered 3 in the Parish of Stewartby in the environs of the Rookery South Energy Facility commencing from a point approximately 9 metres east from unaffected Footpath 10 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0231/4157 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a south east direction for approximately 40 metres where it terminates as a cul-de-sac under the railway bridge at OSGR TL 0233/4154 shown as Point B on the Order Map to a route commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of the unaffected part of Footpath 3, Stewartby at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0233/4154 shown as Point C on the Order map then running in a generally south east direction for approximately 40 metres until it reaches a junction with the unaffected part of Footpath 3, Stewartby at Ordnance Grid Reference OSGR TL 0236/4152 shown as Point D on the Order map

Compensation for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order is payable under Section 28 as applied by section 121(2) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended by the Transport and Works Act 1992) that are copied with this notice.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford by appointment from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
