PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2023**

The above Order made on 07 December 2023 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish that part of Public Footpath number 3 Stewartby that commences from a cul-de-sac at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0240/4174 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally south east direction for approximately 32 metres to a junction with the unaffected part of Footpath 3, Stewartby at OSGR TL 0242/4172 shown as Point B on the order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford by appointment from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
