- (c) the discovery by the surveying authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows:
- (i) that a right of way which is not shown on the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which Part III applies.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Bedford Borough Council order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 15 July 2020.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for The Former North Bedfordshire Borough shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Definitive Map and Statement for The Former North Bedfordshire Borough) (Riseley: ~~Byway Open to All Traffic~~ No. 71) Modification Order 2020".

##### Description of Path or Way to be Added

~~A Byway Open to All Traffic~~ in the Parish of Riseley to be numbered 71 in the Definitive Statement commencing from a point where it has a junction with the northernmost extent of the Borough Highway "Dag Lane" which is shown on the List of Streets as a highway maintainable at public expense approximately 11 metres north-north-east of number 3 Dag Lane, Riseley at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0364/6288 shown as Point "A" on the map attached to this order then running in a generally north-westerly and north-north-easterly direction for 395 metres to a point where it terminates without having a junction with any other highway at OSGR TL 0368/6321 shown as Point "B" on the Map attached to the Order.
