BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO EXTEND EXISTING PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN LYNTON GROVE, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Ward Councillors to extend the existing parking restrictions in Lynton Grove at its junction with Ampthill Road, Bedford. This is in response to concerns raised over inconsiderate parking at this location which affects visibility and safety, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

Effect of the Order:

- 1. To extend existing 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:**

A	Lynton Grove (southern arm), Bedford
(i)	On both sides of the road, from a point approx. 5 metres east of the eastern side of Ampthill Road (the end of the existing 'No waiting at any time' restriction) to a point approx. 10 metres east of the eastern side of Ampthill Road.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
