

Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order

Highways Act 1980

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BEDFORD (FORMER EXCLUDED AREA): PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ON FOOT BETWEEN MAITLAND STREET AND COSTIN STREET) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020

On 18 December 2023 the Secretary of State confirmed the above Order made under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish a Public Footpath in the former excluded area of Bedford Town commencing from a point where it has a junction with the eastern margin of publicly maintained road, Western Street, Bedford, between numbers 7 and 13 Western Street at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0458/4958 shown as Point A on the Order map then running in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to the point where it has a junction with the western margin of publicly maintained road, Battison Street, Bedford, between numbers 6 and 8, Battison Street, Bedford at OSGR TL 0462/4960 shown as Point B on the Order map.

The Order comes into force on 25 December 2023, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 11 January 2024 make an application to the High Court.
