

PUBLIC NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO ESTABLISH A TOUCAN CROSSING ON CLAPHAM ROAD, BEDFORD

<u>Reason for Proposal:</u> The developer is required to provide a new Toucan Crossing on Clapham Road as part of the planning and Section 278 Agreements in connection with the construction of the new school off Manton Lane, Bedford.

<u>The Location of the Proposed Toucan Crossing</u> is on Clapham Road, Bedford, outside Clapham Water Treatment Works. The centre of the crossing will be approximately 16.5 metres south of the southern boundary of property no. 140 Clapham Road.

<u>Further Details</u> of the proposed toucan crossing, a plan and a statement of reasons for proposing to establish the crossing may be examined during normal working hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford. These documents are also available on the <u>www.bedford.gov.uk/tro</u> website. The details will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the crossings are commissioned or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
