

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE 2 NEW ZEBRA CROSSINGS AND PARKING RESTRICTION CHANGES ON WAVENEY AVENUE, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) Bedford Borough Council propose to establish 2 new zebra crossings in Waveney Avenue, Bedford. The proposal is intended to improve pedestrian safety in Waveney Avenue, as the zebra crossings will provide identified, controlled crossing points for pedestrians.

To facilitate the carriageway lining associated with the new zebra crossings, it will be necessary to re-locate a bus stop and revoke some double yellow lines and No Loading marks. The double yellow lines and No Loading marks will be replaced by the requisite zebra crossing zig-zag lines.

Effect of the Proposal:

1. To establish new zebra crossings at the following location:-

Α	Waveney Avenue, Bedford
(i)	The centre of the first zebra crossing is approx. 12 metres north-east of the
1 , , ,	centre of the northern arm of Falcon Avenue on the north-western side of
	Waveney Avenue.
(ii)	The centre of the second zebra crossing is approx. 50 metres north-east of
, ,	the centre of Severn Way.

2. To revoke and remove the 'No waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:-

Α	Waveney Avenue, Bedford
(i)	On its north-western kerb, extending from a point approx. 30 metres north-
1 1	east of the centre of Severn Way for a distance of approx. 27.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.

3. To revoke and remove the 'No loading at any time' restriction (kerb marks) on the following length of road:

Α	Waveney Avenue, Bedford
(i)	On its north-western kerb, extending from a point approx. 48.8 metres north-
	east of the centre of Severn Way for a distance of approx. 8.7 metres in a
	north-easterly direction.

They will also be available for viewing on the council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/proposedtro. The documents will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal. BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 (Amendment No.97) Order 2023" and shall come into force on 21st August 2023.
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into force the provisions of the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended shall be varied as follows:
 - (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: K 19 Revision No: 7" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: K 19 Revision No: 8" shall be inserted.
 - (ii) The plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: L 18 Revision No: 4" shall be deleted and the plan schedule reference "Grid Ref: L 18 Revision No: 5" shall be inserted.
- This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Bedford Urban Area (North of the River Excluding Queens

Park and CPZ Areas)) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2009 as amended.





STATEMENT OF REASONS




