

## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (CAR TRANSPORTERS RESTRICTION) (THURLEIGH) ORDER 2024

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL ("the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Car Transporters Restriction) (Thurleigh) Order 2024" and shall come into force on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2024.
- 2. In this Order "car transporter" means a non-rigid vehicle in excess of 12 metres in length, as defined in the DfT's Guidance for the maximum length of vehicles used in Great Britain, and as set out in the "Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986 (as amended).
- 3. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause to be driven any non-rigid car transporter having a length in excess of 12 metres on any length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the said lengths of road").
- 5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a non-rigid car transporter having a length in excess of 12 metres to proceed on any of the said lengths of road if the vehicle is being used:-
  - for fire and rescue service, ambulance service, police, National Crime Agency or special forces purposes;
  - (b) for public service vehicle purposes;
  - in the service of a local authority, water undertaker, sewerage undertaker or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operation on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road;
- in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road;
- (f) in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road;
- (g) in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 4(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (h) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road, or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land;
- (i) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road;
- (j) for the purposes of loading, unloading or garaging of vehicles at any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road;
- (k) in connection with the removal or delivery of furniture from or to premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road or any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road.
- 6. The Council are satisfied that by restricting the use of the said lengths of road by non-rigid vehicles having a length in excess of 12 metres for the prevention of damage to the said lengths of road and any other road accessible from and only from the said lengths of road, and for the prevention of damage to the buildings on or near them, and for the preservation and improvement of the amenities of the villages of Thurleigh, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply to this Order.
- 7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

#### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

Due to unsuitability of various minor roads, Bedford Borough Council proposes to restrict access by car transporters to signed key routes only to the car storage facility off Thurleigh Road, Milton Earnest and Thurleigh Airfield.
