THIS ORDER is made by the Bedford Borough Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interest of the public the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient in the interest of the applicant landowner that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

The Landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public rights of way over the land situated in the environs of "Hinton St Mary", in the Parish of Bolnhurst & Keysoe and shown by a bold continuous line between Points A – B on the map attached to this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 (seven) days from the date of confirmation of this Order
- 2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, in respect of their apparatus under, in, upon, over, along or across the said land as they had immediately before the date of confirmation of this Order
- 3. DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That length of Public Footpath numbered 85 in the Parish of Bolnhurst & Keysoe in the environs of "Hinton St Mary" commencing from a point approximately 8 metres south-east from the residential dwelling known as "Hinton St Mary" Bolnhurst & Keysoe at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0906/5826 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally north-north-east direction for approximately 123 metres where it joins the unaffected part of Footpath 85 at OSGR TL 0909/5837 shown as Point B on the Order Map.

The Definitive Statement records no information regarding the width of the path. For the avoidance of doubt, it is intended for this Order to stop up the length of Public Footpath described above in its entirety.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A length of Public Footpath to be created in the Parish of Bolnhurst & Keysoe by this Order in the environs of "Hinton St Mary" commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of the unaffected part of Footpath 85, Bolnhurst & Keysoe approximately 8 metres south-east from the residential dwelling known as "Hinton St Mary" Bolnhurst & Keysoe at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0906/5826 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally north-east direction for approximately 123 metres where it joins the unaffected part of Footpath 85 at OSGR TL 0909/5837 shown as Point B on the Order Map.

The new length of Public Footpath described above shall have a width of 2.0 (two) metres throughout.
