



Notice of Making a Public Path Order

Highways Act 1980

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BOLNHURST & KEYSOE: PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH No. 85) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

The above Order made on 14 March 2024 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert that length of Public Footpath numbered 85 in the Parish of Bolnhurst & Keysoe in the environs of "Hinton St Mary" commencing from a point approximately 8 metres south-east from the residential dwelling known as "Hinton St Mary" Bolnhurst & Keysoe at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0906/5826 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally north-north-east direction for approximately 123 metres where it joins the unaffected part of Footpath 85 at OSGR TL 0909/5837 shown as Point B on the Order Map to a point commencing from where it has a junction with that part of the unaffected part of Footpath 85, Bolnhurst & Keysoe approximately 8 metres south-east from the residential dwelling known as "Hinton St Mary" Bolnhurst & Keysoe at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0906/5826 shown as Point A on the attached map then running in a generally north-east direction for approximately 123 metres where it joins the unaffected part of Footpath 85 at OSGR TL 0909/5837 shown as Point B on the Order Map.

Compensation for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order is payable under Section 28 as applied by section 121(2) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended by the Transport and Works Act 1992) that are copied with this notice.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford by appointment from 10am to 4pm on Weekdays (Bank and Public Holidays excepted). If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn Bedford Borough Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
