

Notice of Making a Public Path Order

Town and Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257 and Paragraph 1 of Schedule 14

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (MELCHBOURNE AND YIELDEN: PART OF BRIDLEWAY No. 20) (AGRICULTURAL BUILDING NORTH EAST OF GRANGE FARM MK44 1BJ) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

The above Order was made on 21 March 2024 under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. Planning reference is 24/00006/FUL. The effect of the order will be to divert that length of Public Bridleway number M20 in the Parish of Melchbourne and Yielden commencing from a point where it has a junction with that part of Public Bridleway number M20 Melchbourne and Yielden to be retained, approximately 83 metres north-east of Grange Farm at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0306/6680 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a generally east direction for approximately 65 metres to a point approximately 135 metres north-east of Grange Farm at OSGR TL 0312/6680 shown as Point B on the Order Map to a route commencing from a point where it has a junction with the unaffected part of Bridleway M20 Melchbourne and Yielden approximately 83 metres north-east of Grange Farm at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 0306/6680 shown as Point A on the order map then running in a north direction for approximately 11 metres and then running in an east direction for approximately 55 metres and then in a south-east direction for approximately 14 metres to a point where it rejoins the unaffected part of Bridleway M20 Melchbourne and Yielden approximately 135 metres north-east of Grange Farm at OSGR TL 0312/6680 shown as Point B on the Order Map.
