(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that Bedford Borough Council intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any mechanically propelled vehicle or horse drawn vehicle to proceed along the following lanes.

NEWTON LANE (UC 286(ii), Knotting & Souldrop BOAT No 8 and part of Melchbourne & Yelden BOAT No Y8): from its junction with Melchbourne Road, Knotting at O.S. Grid Reference (OSGR) TL0064-6383 for approx 1800m to Newton Gorse, Newton Bromswold at OSGR TL0008-6557.

FARNDISH ROAD (UC279(i) and Podington BOAT No 3): from its junction with the C14 Irchester Road at OSGR SP9283-6421 for approx 2220m to its junction with the C12 Wymington Road at OSGR SP9493-6369.

All of the above lanes will remain open to pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists and motorcyclists.

These temporary closures will only be in place during wet conditions if required due to surface damage which would be likely if they were used by vehicles. The closures will be operational from 1st May 2024 for up to six months.
